Punctuality is very important and children don't like going into their class late as they miss out on their learning so please try hard to get to school on time.

Staffing

Staff currently on maternity leave are – Mrs Bell (formerly known as Miss Robinson), Mrs Rowland (Teacher), Miss Proudman-Brown (Deputy Team Leader Bailey's Butterflies), Miss Howey (Bailey's Butterflies TA) and Miss Dawson (TA in school).

Miss Gallon Year 1 Teacher will start her maternity leave in October and Miss Harvey will teach the Year 1 class. She has currently been teaching alongside Miss Gallon.

Congratulations to Mrs Moat who is expecting her first child and will start her maternity leave in December.

Mrs Close has started her new role as Assistant Headteacher, working alongside myself and Mrs Morgan Deputy Head.

Attendance

We aim for all children to have excellent attendance at Bailey Green. There is a clear link between attendance and academic progress and achievement. We would like all children to aim for an attendance of between 95 - 100% in order to achieve their full potential in school. I really want to work towards excellent attendance this year so please try hard to have your children in school unless they are too ill to attend.

If your child is poorly and unable to attend school, we ask that you call the absence line on 0191 2509025 or report it on ParentApp before 8.45am on each day of their absence. If your child is off with a sickness and diarrhoea bug they will be required to stay off school for 48 hours after the last bout.

If you can, please avoid making any medical appointments during the school day.

Uniform

We expect all children to wear school uniform and school shoes, NO trainers! We are beginning to build up a supply of used uniform in school and Baileys Butterflies. If you need support please get in touch.

We do not allow extreme hairstyles, shaved heads or dyed hair. We do ask for no bright coloured nail polish to be worn in school. Earrings must be studs only, and your child must be able to remove them or put a plaster over for PE lessons.

Clubs

We will be sending letters out very soon for any clubs that will be available for your children. The list will then be published on our school website.

Holiday Club

Mr Harrison led our summer clubs for KS1 and KS2 children during the school holidays. This went really well and the parent feedback was very positive.

Wrap Around Care

Breakfast Club is open from 7.45am – 8.30am, the gates are open from 7.45am – 8.00am After School Club closes at 5.30pm.

ALL sessions must be booked and paid for in advance using Scopay, unless you pay by childcare vouchers, then this must be sent when a session is booked through the main school office. We do understand that circumstances may arise where a session will need to be booked in on the day, therefore we can allow this if it is an emergency. We do not use private providers for our wrap around care, we have our own school staff whom the children know.

We do not want to be chasing payments owed as unfortunately we are not in a position to run our wrap around care on unpaid costs. As you can appreciate we have staffing, bills and food costs to cover, therefore we can no longer allow any accounts to go into debt.

The prices are:

Breakfast Club 7.45 am – 8.30 am (gate closes promptly at 8.00am)

After School Club 3.00pm – 5.30 pm

A set amount for each session is charged:

Breakfast Club 7.45am £2.00 includes toast or cereal and a drink.

After School 3.00pm – 4.00pm £5.00 (no snack)

4.00 pm - 5.30 pm £7.00 (with snack at 4.30 pm)

Reception parents should have all received a unique login to get signed up. If you have not yet received the code please get in touch with the school office.

Medical Information

If your child has an inhaler or epi-pen, you do need to complete and return the new medical form. You can request a form by emailing the school office, this is not available to download on the website.

Holidays

Any holidays taken during school time will not be authorised. Although we do not encourage holidays during term time, if you do plan to have a holiday during school time you must complete a leave of absence form.

School Dinners

The menu is on our school website and the cost has increased to £2.60 per day. School meals continue to be free for all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 as part of Universal Free School Meals.

Parents/ Carers of children in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 who do not receive free benefit related free school meals, can pay for lunches using ParentPay. If you have any questions or queries about Parent Pay, please email parentpay@northtyneside.gov.uk. Butterflies and Nursery children are still to pay for lunches as normal.

Snacks

KS1 children do not need to bring in a snack as they are provided with fruit and vegetables. KS2 children can bring in a healthy snack for playtime. A piece of fruit is a good choice.

Packed lunches

We do prefer children to have a 'hot school lunch', however if you are providing your child with a packed lunch, please try to give healthy choices e.g. sandwich, piece of fruit, yoghurt and vegetables. Cakes, biscuits and crisps are lovely, but please try to limit these and choose a healthier option.

Water

Your child is provided with water throughout the day to keep their bottle topped up. Children can bring in their own water bottle or we do sell them in school for £1.50. No juice please!

Halloween

We will not be dressing up in school this year with Halloween being in the half term holidays. We will be having other discos and events during the school year.

Pantomime

We are so excited to tell you we will be going to the Christmas Panto at Whitley Bay Playhouse this year on Tuesday 19th December. We will be taking children from Reception to Year 6. You will receive further information on this in due course.

It is very important that you keep a constant check on parentapp as this is where all communication will be sent. You can set up notifications on your phone so that you don't miss any letters, messages etc.

Parent lunch will run from 12.45pm – 1.15pm, we do encourage your child to stay for a school dinner and not a packed lunch on these days. The cost of the parent lunch is £3.65 per person. You will need to book this via Scopay.
