### In English we will be exploring:

- Traditional tales

- Information texts



### In Maths the children will be learning:

- Addition with partitioning
- Number facts
- 2, 3, 5 and 10 x tables
- Units of measure and time
- Position and direction

### Science: Living Things and their Habitats

Children will explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive. They will find out that most living things live in a habitat which suits them and how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants, and how they depend on each other.

**Please do not send your child in with backpacks as we are short of space!**



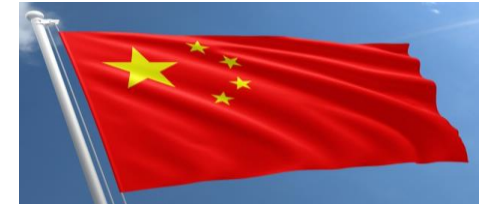
### PE – Tuesdays
