English

Grammar, spelling and punctuation will be taught daily.

Children will have weekly phonics sessions with Essential Letters and Sounds to recap tricky Phase 5 alternative spellings.

Children will also take part in daily reading activities.

Genres covered:

- Poetry
- Explanation Texts

Maths

In maths this term we will be working on:

- Fractions of amounts
- Decimals within place value
- Money word problems including change

Revision in basic skills – telling the time

Times tables will be practised daily.

Homework will be handed out in homework books on **Fridays** and should be completed and handed back to school by the following **Wednesday**.

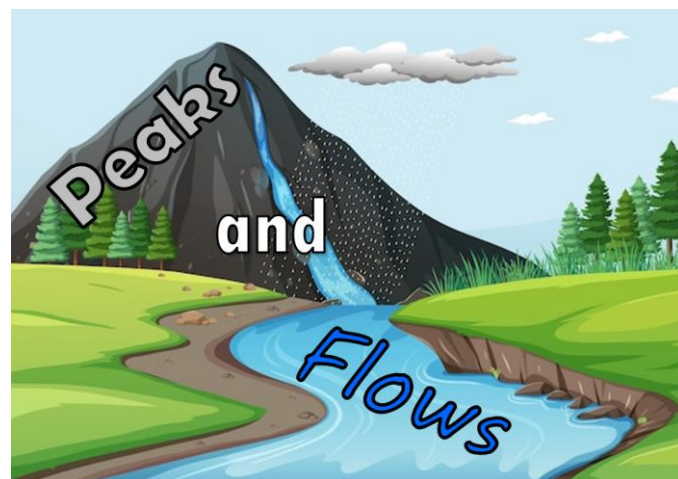

Geography

In **Geography** the children will be finding out about the **Mountains and Rivers**

We will...

- Identify the main mountains of the UK
- Find out about contour lines on a map and how they work.
- Identify the main rivers of the UK.
- Identify the main parts of a river course.
- Recap the water cycle and the role of mountains and rivers in the water cycle.

Science

In Science we will focus on **Animals, including Humans** and will...

- Describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans.
- Identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions.

Computing: We will be introducing email and online collaborative tools, learning how to safely and appropriately use Outlook and One Drive.

PE: We will be improving our jumping, travelling and performance by taking in dance.

PSHE: We will be continuing to find out about how our data is shared and used. We will also be looking at making decisions about using money and keeping it safe.

Music: We will be finding out about adapting music to different purposes and transposing different motifs.

Art: We will be developing skills in colour mixing, focussing on using tints and shades to create a 3D effect.

French: We will continue to develop our vocabulary linked to Shopping, Dates and times, and clothing.
